ORDER

Bail application filed under Sec.438 Cr.P.C.

2. Petitioners are accused in Crime No.2008 of 2015 of Fort Police station, Thiruvananthapuram registered for the offences punishable under Sec.306 of the Indian Penal Code, Secs.13 and 17 of the Kerala Money Lenders Act and Secs.3 and 9 of Kerala Prohibition of Charging Exorbitant Interest Act. Prosecution case in short is that the deceased availed a loan of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees fifteen thousand only) from the 1st petitioner. It is further alleged that the petitioners pestered the deceased demanding money with exorbitant interest which prompted her to commit self immolation.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Public Prosecutor.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners were in dire need of money

and they asked for return of money. They have not commit any offence.

Considering the nature of allegations, pre arrest bail is granted to the petitioners with the following conditions.

1. The petitioners shall surrender before the investigating officer within a period of two weeks and submit themselves for interrogation.

2. In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on their executing a bond for Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) each with two solvent sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the investigating officer.

3. The petitioners shall appear before the Investigating Officer for interrogation as and when directed by him in writing.

4. The petitioners shall not intimidate or attempt to influence the witnesses, nor shall

they tamper with the evidence.

In case of violation of any of the above conditions, the learned Magistrate is empowered to cancel the bail in accordance with law without referring the matter to this Court.
