ORDER

Application filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

2. The petitioner is the second accused in Crime No.777/2015 of Thamarassery Police Station registered under Sections 332, 341 and 323 IPC.

3. The prosecution case is that, the petitioner along with other accused voluntarily caused hurt to a KSRTC driver while he was on duty. The incident was on 25.10.2015.

4. Heard both sides.

5. As per order in B.A. No.7086/2015, this Court granted pre-arrest bail to the first accused on 17.11.2015.

6. Considering the nature of allegations pre-arrest bail is granted to the petitioner on the same conditions:

1. The petitioner shall surrender before the investigating officer within a period of two weeks and submit himself for interrogation.

2. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on his executing a bond for

*Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only)
with two solvent sureties each for the like sum to
the satisfaction of the investigating officer.*

*3. The petitioner shall appear before the
Investigating Officer for interrogation as and
when directed to do so in writing.*

*4. The petitioner shall not intimidate or
attempt to influence the witnesses, nor shall he
tamper with the evidence.*

In case of violation of any of the above conditions, the
learned Magistrate is empowered to cancel the bail in accordance
with law without referring the matter to this Court.
