ORDER

Application filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

2. Petitioner is the 1st accused in Crime No.678 of 2015 of New Mahi Police Station registered for the offences punishable under Section 353 r/w Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Prosecution case is that on 17.10.2015 at about 01.50 a.m., two policemen were on patrol duty and they saw a car driven by the petitioner stopping in front of a closed railway gate. When the Police Constables approached the car and asked the address of the driver, the petitioner abused the Police Constables and tried to take away the vehicle against the lawful exercise of their duty.

4. Heard both sides.

5. Considering the nature of the allegations, the following directions are issued:

- (a) Petitioner shall surrender before the Investigating Officer within a period of 'two weeks' from today and submit himself for interrogation. Thereafter, he shall be released on bail on executing a bond for ₹25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) with two solvent sureties for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.
- (b) The petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when directed for the purpose of interrogation.
- (c) The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigation of the case.
- (d) The petitioner shall not intimidate or attempt to influence the witnesses.
- (e) The petitioner shall not in any manner interfere or meddle with the investigation.
- (f) The petitioner shall not, during the period of this bail get involved in any offence.

In case any of the above conditions is violated, bail granted hereby is liable to be cancelled for which the investigating officer may move application before the jurisdictional magistrate.
