Shaffique, J.

This contempt case has been filed complaining non compliance of the directions in the judgment dated 05.06.2008 in W.P.(C) No.3012 of 2008.

2. By the aforesaid judgment the interim order granted on 29.05.2008 has been made absolute. By the interim order the petitioner was permitted to file appropriate complaint if there is a threat to his life and direction was issued to the Sub Inspector of Police, Museum Police Station to render necessary protection to his life.

3. Petitioner submits that the threat continues by one Sreekumar who is the driver of 8th respondent. Be that as it may, we do not find that there is any willful contempt committed by the respondents herein. It is always open for the petitioner to file appropriate complaint before the Station House Officer, on subsequent cause of action.
