JUDGMENT

A.M.Shaffique, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court complaining of willful contempt. It is contended that directions had been issued by this Court in judgment dated 18.12.2013 in WP (C) No.17148 of 2012 directing the police to take appropriate action to prevent the illegal activities of the Students' Union within the college campus. There was incidents on 20th and 22nd January, 2014, by which a faction of students went on strike, though police officers were presented in the campus of the college, no action has been taken to ensure functioning of the college.

2. Affidavit has been filed by the 4th respondent inter alia stating that sufficient police force had been deployed in the campus, where the strike being

conducted by certain faction of students. The police force was withdrawn only after getting intimation from the Principal that there is no necessity for police force to remain in the campus. Since appropriate action had already been taken by the police in the matter, we do not find, this is a case in which willful contempt has been committed by the respondents.

Accordingly, this contempt case is closed.
