ORDER

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It seems that the learned Magistrate has passed an order by restraining the petitioner herein from operating his bank account being maintained by him at the South Indian Bank, Jerome Nagar Branch, Kollam. Some other orders are also passed. It seems that notice was issued to the petitioner from the court below and the notice had returned as 'unclaimed'. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, his party says that no intimation was served to him by the postal authorities.

2. Whatever it is, the present way out of the petitioner is to approach the court below under Section 25 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act for modification or alteration of the conditions or to file an appeal before the Sessions Court, Thiruvananthapuram. In

case such an application is filed before the learned Magistrate, the learned Magistrate shall advance the case to a nearest date and dispose of the application, as expeditiously as possible.

With the said observations, this CrI.M.C. is closed.
