The petitioners herein seek some prayers on some anticipated cause of action. Presently there is no crime or complaint against them. They apprehend that the respondents may bring some complaint. Accordingly, they seek a direction under Section 482 Cr.P.C to the police that they shall not be summoned to the police station without ascertaining the genuineness and truth of the allegations in the complaint. The prayer is really strange. Presently, there is no proceeding against them under the Code of Criminal Procedure.
