When the matter came up for hearing, the learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that all proceedings in Crime No.272 of 2013 of Kottackal police station, Malappuram, challenged in this proceeding , has been dropped by the police in view of the fact that the Vigilance and Anti Corruption Bureau, Malappuram, had already registered crimes in respect of the same subject matter against the very same accused as V.C.3 of 2012 and 4 of 2014.
