O R D E R

The above captioned Crl.M.C. has been filed under Sec.482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure with the following prayers:

“.... to direct the Judicial First Class Magistrate Court–III, Thrissur to enlarge the petitioners on bail on the date of surrender itself by considering their bail application in C.P.No.24/2015 arose out of Crime No.427/2014 of Mannuthy Police Station, so as to secure the ends of justice.”

2. Heard Sri.C.A.Chacko, learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent–State of Kerala.

3. Having regard to the totality of the facts and circumstances of this case, it is ordered in the interest of justice that in case the petitioners voluntarily surrender before the Judicial First Class Magistrate Court–III, Thrissur (dealing with C.P.No.24/2015 arose out of Crime No.427/2014 of Mannuthy Police Station), within two weeks from today and submits necessary application for grant of bail, then the court below concerned shall consider the application for bail on the same day itself, in accordance with law and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of this case. It is further ordered that the petitioners shall give advance notice to the Prosecutor concerned attached to

the court below concerned intimating the date and time of surrender before the court below, at least 24 hours prior to such proposed surrender. It is made clear that in case the petitioner does not surrender before the court below concerned within a period of two weeks as directed above, then the direction issued herein above will stand automatically vacated. It is made clear that it is entirely within the province of the court below concerned to decide on the application for bail, in accordance with law.

With these observations and directions, the Crl.M.C. stands finally disposed of.
