ORDER

Petitioner is the accused in L.P.No.102/2013 which was filed as C.C.No.805/2008 of the Judicial First Class Magistrate's Court-I, Attingal, which has arisen from Crime No.227/2008 of the Attingal Police Station, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 427 and 452 of the Indian Penal Code.

2. The petitioner is the son-in-law of the 2nd respondent, who is the defacto complainant. The parties have settled the matter amicably.
