ORDER

Petitioners are A1 to A3 in C.C.No.1218 of 2014 of the Judicial First Class Magistrate's Court-I, Kollam, which has arisen from Crime No.124 of 2013 of the Anchalumood Police Station, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323 and 324 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 34 IPC.

2. The matter has been amicably settled between the petitioners and the defacto complainant, who is the 2nd respondent herein.
