ORDER

Petitioners are the accused in C.C. No. 2471/2014 of the Judicial First Class Magistrate's Court-1, Attingal, which has arisen from Crime No. 1579/2014 of the Attingal Police Station, Thiruvananthapuram District, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 324 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 34 IPC.

2. The matter has been amicably settled between the petitioners and the defacto complainant, who is the 2nd respondent and the other injured, who is the 3rd respondent herein.
