ORDER

Petitioners are the accused in C.C. No. 583/2013 of the Chief Judicial Magistrate's Court, Kasaragod, which has arisen from Crime No. 254/2013 of the Kumbala Police Station, Kasaragod, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 294(b) and 506(ii) read with Section 34 IPC.

2. The matter has been amicably settled between the petitioners and the defacto complainant, who is the 2nd respondent and the other injured, who is the 3rd respondent herein. The defacto complainant and the other injured have filed separate affidavits as Annexures A – 2(a) and A-2 (b) affirming that the matter has been amicably settled
