ORDER

Petitioners are accused in C.C.No.2106 of 2015 of the Judicial First Class Magistrate's Court-III, Neyyattinkara, which has arisen from Crime No.74 of 2015 of the Marayamuttom Police Station, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324, 341 and 379 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

2. The matter has been amicably settled between the petitioners and the defacto complainant, who is the 2nd respondent herein. The defacto complainant has filed Annexure-II affidavit affirming that the matter has been amicably settled between him and the petitioners and he has no complaints against the petitioners.

3. No criminal antecedents have been reported against the petitioners. When the matter has been amicably settled, no purpose would be served in proceeding with the
