J U D G M E N T

Abdul Rehim, J:

Counsel appearing on both sides conceded that the issues involved in various litigations pertaining to the matrimonial dispute pending before different courts between the parties. The appellant had filed I.A. No.1720/2015 in Mat. Appeal No.250/2014 and Crl. M.A. No.2672/2015 in RP (FC) No.119/2014 seeking to record the compromise arrived and to dispose of the above appeal in terms of the compromise.
