JUDGMENT

The defendant in O.S.22 of 2013 has come up with this Original Petition seeking a direction to the court below to dispose of the suit as expeditiously as possible.

2. The suit is one for fixation of boundary and for other consequential reliefs. The defendant entered appearance and filed a written statement.

3. It may be mentioned that several other reliefs are also sought for in the suit. The defendant has pointed out that the suit is ripe for trial and the pendency of the suit is causing considerable difficulties to him. Therefore, it is prayed that, there may be a direction to dispose of the suit as expeditiously as possible.

4. In the nature of the order that is proposed to be passed in this Original Petition, notice to the respondents appears to be unnecessary,

This Original Petition is disposed of directing the Munsiff's Court, Sasthamcotta to take up O.S. 22 of 2013, provided it is ripe for trial and no interlocutory applications are pending for consideration, and include in the list for the month of June, 2015 and dispose it of as expeditiously as possible, at any rate, within a period of six months from the date of listing of the case.
