JUDGMENT

The petitioner herein is the 5th accused in C.C.No.1108/2013 of the Judicial First Class Magistrate Court-I, Neyyattinkara. She seeks a direction for speedy disposal of the case. There is report by the learned Magistrate that charge has already been framed in the case, but trial is yet to commence. The prosecution has cited eight witnesses in the case, it is reported. The learned Magistrate has also reported that the total pendency in the court is 9610 cases. However, the learned Magistrate is confident that the case could be disposed of within five months.
