The petitioner herein seeks a direction for expeditious disposal of an application filed by him for interim custody of a vehicle under Section 451 Cr.P.C as C.M.P No.3419 of 2015. Now there is a report by the learned Magistrate that the application stands posted to 20.05.2015 for production of the originals of the required documents, including registration certificate. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will produce all documents on 20.05.2015 itself. If so, the matter can be disposed of without any delay by the learned Magistrate.
