J U D G M E N T

The petitioner approached this Court seeking for a direction to the Debt Recovery Tribunal (DRT) to issue the certified copy of the order dated 28.1.2013 passed in D.R.C.No.562 and connected cases.

2. The learned CGC points out that the application for certified copies suffers from defects and the petitioner has not cured the defects.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner on verifying the same submits that the application for certified copies have defects and the same will be cured within two days.
