JUDGMENT

Surendra Mohan, J.

The limited relief sought for by the petitioner, when the matter is taken up today, is for reserving his right to pursue his efforts before the Government to have the Special Rules amended as requested for by him, without any impediment being caused by the dismissal of the O.A. as per Ext.P1 order. Having heard the counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as the learned Government Pleader, we are satisfied that there can be no impediment in the petitioner pursuing his efforts to persuade the Government to amend the Special Rules as sought for by him in spite of the dismissal of his O.A. by Ext.P1 order.

In view of the above, this Original Petition is disposed of reserving the right of the petitioner to pursue his efforts before the Government for having the Special Rules amended irrespective of the dismissal of the O.A. by Ext.P1 order.
