ORDER

Ramachandran Nair, J.

This review petition is filed by the petitioners pointing out that an arithmetical mistake has occurred in the judgment in paragraph 3 especially in the table showing the details of the compensation under various heads.

2. We heard the learned counsel on both sides.

3. As regards item No.11- loss of dependency, the amount awarded is shown as 600120/-, but the calculation should be as the following :

$6000 \times 12 \times 15 \times 2/3 = ₹7,20,000/-$, instead of ₹600120/-.

We therefore allow the review petition. The amount will stand corrected accordingly and will be incorporated in the judgment. The total compensation will be ₹11,73,600/-. The said figure will be

substituted instead of the earlier one. The corrected copy of the judgment will be issued.
