J U D G M E N T

The writ petition is filed challenging motor vehicle tax. This Court, on 22/02/2006, granted an interim order of stay on condition that the petitioner deposits Rs.50,000/- on or before 25/03/2006. The petitioner did not comply with the said order. The petitioner's case is that his vehicle is garaged and therefore he is not liable to pay the amount.

2. The tax payable is in respect of the vehicle and therefore any person who is in possession is bound to pay tax in respect of the vehicle. In that view of the matter, I do not find any merit in the writ petition, accordingly, the same is dismissed.
