JUDGMENT

Thottathil B. Radhakrishnan, J.

We have heard the learned counsel for the appellant and the learned Senior Government Pleader.

2. The appellant lost the writ petition before the learned single Judge. The plea was that the writ petitioner's team was entitled to be ranked first in the 'Thiruvathirakali' competition in connection with the Revenue Jilla Kalolsavam. The learned single Judge noted that the appeal was considered by the competent body and that there was a difference of 7.5 marks between the petitioner's team and the first place winner. No error of procedure was found by the learned single Judge. There is no illegality pointed out warranting interference under Article 227 of the Constitution. We see no ground to interfere in this writ appeal either. This writ appeal fails.

In the result, this writ appeal is dismissed.
