JUDGMENT

Petitioner submits that she was appointed as a Urdu teacher in a retirement vacancy from 16.06.2008 onwards. However, it is submitted that the appointment was only approved on daily wages between the period from 16.06.2008 to 31.03.2009. Challenging the above, petitioner filed a revision under Rule 92 of Chapter XIV A of Kerala Education Rules 1959 before the second respondent. Petitioner relies on the judgment in **State of Kerala Vs. Sneha Cheriyan & Ors (2013(1) KLT 755)** and submits that she is entitled for approval of appointment on regular basis for the above period.

2. In view of pendency of Ext.P4, there shall be a direction to the first respondent to take up Ext.P4 revision after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and pass appropriate orders within a period of four months after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

The Writ Petition is disposed of as above.
