JUDGMENT

The petitioner has submitted Ext.P6 representation challenging the demand made under Exts.P1, P2 and P3 bills. The contention in short is that the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of a scheme brought out by the Central Government. The Electricity Board points out that necessary inputs from the Agricultural Officer concerned may also be necessary.

2. I direct the third respondent to consider Ext.P6 representation with notice to the petitioner and the Agricultural Officer concerned. Every endeavour shall be made to pass final orders thereon within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.

The Writ Petition is disposed of.
