JUDGMENT

The first respondent bank submits that respondents 6 to 10 have only been accommodated in the supernumerary posts created pursuant to Exts.P4 to P6 orders. It necessarily follows that their appointments will not eat into the regular vacancies which have to be filled up from Ext.P1 rank list only. The first respondent bank is therefore directed to fill up the regular vacancies from Ext.P1 rank list dependent on its availability.

The Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
