JUDGMENT

Obviously the election notification has been issued by the 1st respondent while Section 25B of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 prescribes that all elections to the Co-operative Societies shall be notified by the State Co-operative Election Commission. In such circumstances, the election notified as per Ext.P2 shall stand set aside. The Joint Registrar shall take expeditious steps to see that there is no vacuum in the Management as also ensure that the conduct of elections is carried out expeditiously.

The writ petition is disposed of, leaving the parties to suffer their respective costs.
