JUDGMENT

Shaffique, J.

Petitioners have approached this Court seeking police protection. First Petitioner is the President of the Hospital. On account of certain incident which happened on 13-03-2013, according to the petitioners, an attempt was being made to cause obstruction to the functioning of the hospital. An interim order had already been passed by this Court on 10-1-2014.
