J U D G M E N T

Ext.P4 order accompanied by Ext.P5 penal bill is being challenged in a statutory appeal. Ext.P9 appeal if accompanied by the statutory deposit under Section 127 of the Electricity Act shall be entertained by the third respondent.

2. I direct the third respondent to deal with Ext.P9 appeal on merits within a period of four months. The coercive steps as against the petitioner shall be put on hold if the statutory deposit equivalent to one-half of the amount demanded under Ext.P5 notice is deposited. The deposit shall be made within a period of one month from today.

The Writ Petition is disposed of as above.
