JUDGMENT

The petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayer:

“To issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ order direction directing the 1st respondent to dispose off Ext.P1 within a time frame to be fixed by this Honourable Court.”

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents 3 to 6 herein have made encroachment into the Government property and the petitioner has moved the 1st respondent by filing Ext.P1 as early as on May, 2013. There is callous in action on the part of the concerned respondent in taking necessary steps and hence the writ petition.

3. Heard the learned Government Pleader as well.

4. Considering the limited nature of relief sought for, this Court does not find it necessary to go into the merits of the case or to issue notice to respondents 3 to 6 for the time being. The writ petition is disposed of, directing the 1st respondent to consider and dispose of Ext. P1 representation in accordance with

law, with notice to the petitioner as well as respondents 3 to 6, at the earliest, at any rate, within 'one month' from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.

The petitioner shall produce a copy of the judgment along with a copy of the writ petition before the 1st respondent for further steps.
