JUDGMENT

The petitioners' team participated in the event 'Chavittunadakam' in the District Level School Kalolsavam. The allegation is that, the 2nd respondent cancelled their 1st prize as per Ext.P3 and hence the writ petition.

2. The learned Government Pleader submits on instructions that, there is no basis in the contentions raised. Petitioners 5 and 6 obtained two admission numbers who registered in four events and participated in three events. It is stated that, steps are being taken to take disciplinary action against the Head Master.

3. After going through the pleadings and proceedings and the submissions of the learned Government Pleader, this Court finds that the petitioners have not established any tenable ground to call for interference. Accordingly, interference is declined and the writ petition is dismissed.
