JUDGMENT

The petitioner's team participated in the event 'Arabanamuttu' (Boys) in the District Level School Kalolsavam and could secure only the second place with A Grade. The appeal was rejected by the Appeal Committee as per Ext.P3 order allegedly without considering the contention that the performance was affected due to the belated start and hence the writ petition.

2. The learned Government Pleader submits on instructions that, there is no basis in the contentions raised. The allegation, with regard to the belated start is wrong and that it was applicable to all participants.

3. After going through the pleadings and proceedings and the submissions of the learned Government Pleader, this Court finds that the petitioner has not established any tenable ground to call for interference. Accordingly, interference is declined and the writ petition is dismissed.
