- (i) Issue a writ of mandamus or any appropriate writ, order or direction, directing the respondents 1 and 2 to take effective steps to prevent unlawful felling of trees from the land taken possession of from Ceiling Case No.TLB(SR) 484 - Talappally (LR6);
- (ii) Order such other reliefs that are just and proper in the circumstances of the case.
