JUDGMENT

The petitioner is a Constable in the Railway Protection Force. The petitioner is working at Aluva and he is staying at Ernakulam. The petitioner submits that he is entitled for Travelling Allowances/Daily allowances as claimed in Ext.P3. The petitioner approached the second respondent by Ext.P4 representation for disbursal of Travelling Allowances/Daily Allowances. The petitioner has a further grievance that the third respondent is not forwarding Ext.P3 to the second respondent.

In view of the above, if the third respondent has not forwarded Ext.P3, necessary decision shall be taken by the second respondent on Ext.P4 within a period of one month after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. If

it is found that the petitioner is entitled, necessarily, the second respondent shall direct the third respondent to forward Ext.P3 and ensure that the Travelling Allowances/Daily Allowances are disbursed to the petitioner.

The writ petition is disposed of as above.
