JUDGMENT

The petitioners have evidently not complied with the interim orders dated 20.01.2015 passed in these writ petitions. The petitioners therefore confine their relief to easy instalments to repay the money due.

2. I permit the petitioners to pay the amount due to the first respondent bank in ten equal monthly instalments. The instalments shall start from 16.03.2015 and any failure to pay as directed can result in coercive steps.

3. The petitioners are also free to avail of the benefit of One Time Settlement scheme if any. Motion in that regard made by the petitioners shall be dealt with by the first respondent bank without delay.

The Writ Petitions are disposed of.
