JUDGMENT

The possession of the property was surrendered as early as on 31.12.2007 pursuant to the Award No. 17/2007 dated 12.12.2007. The enhanced compensation award in LAR No. 436/2009 has been affirmed in LAA No. 179/2013 and E.P. No. 193/2013 is pending. The petitioners are yet to receive any part of the enhanced compensation since the respondents have not yet deposited the requisite money.

2. The Government Pleader on instructions submits that the award could be satisfied within a reasonable period. I therefore direct the respondents to deposit the amount due to the petitioners within a period of four months from today. The respondents shall see to it that the amount due in LAA No. 179/2013 is deposited in EP No. 193/2013 and full satisfaction is recorded within a period of four months.

The Writ Petition is disposed of.
