The petitioner is the owner of a stage carriage, bearing Registration No.KL-55/B 4146, who was granted temporary permit on the route Kadampuzha Temple-Perrinthalmanna in the vacancy of a regular service up to 25.01.2014 and had made an application for re-issue of the temporary permit, by Ext.P2.
