JUDGMENT

The petitioner is seeking for correction of date of birth in the school records and in Ext. P1 caste certificate issued by the first respondent, based on Ext. P2 birth certificate. Admittedly, the petitioner pursued studies in the second respondent school situated in Jodhpur, Rajasthan. The concerned authority of the CBSE is also in the State of Rajasthan, as evident from the description of parties in the cause title and as pleaded. This Court does not have any territorial jurisdiction to deal with the issue. It is open for the petitioner to approach other appropriate forum, for appropriate relief.

Without prejudice to the rights and liberties as above, interference is declined and the writ petition is dismissed.
