JUDGMENT

The petitioner is presently working as Principal of the Attingal Kshethra Kalapeedom under the Travancore Devaswom Board. A vacancy of Principal arose in Vaikom Kshethra Kalapeedom in November, 2014. According to the petitioner, the post remains vacant even now. The petitioner made a representation long prior to the vacancy for a posting as Principal at Vaikom Kshethra Kalapeedom. The petitioner submitted that the Manager of Attingal Kshethra Kalapeedom made a recommendation for the petitioner's posting at Vaikom Kshethra Kalapeedom. It is also submitted that the third respondent also made a recommendation in favour of the petitioner. However, in spite of such recommendation, the post continued to be vacant and no action has been taken

on the petitioner's request for posting at Vaikom Kshethra Kalapeedom.

In view of the claim as above, appropriate decision shall be taken by the first respondent in this matter within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.

The writ petition is disposed of as above.
