JUDGMENT

Ext. P4 demand note is obviously not in tune with Clause 82 of the Kerala Electricity Supply Code, 2014. The details enumerated in Sub-clauses (i) to (iv) of Clause 82(3) are obviously absent.

2. Ext. P4 demand note is hence quashed giving liberty to the respondents to issue a fresh demand note. The petitioner shall not be required to pay the sum of Rs. 10,000/- in addition in view of Clause 83 of the Kerala Electricity Supply Code, 2014. The respondents shall complete the exercise within a period of three weeks from today.

The writ petition is disposed of.
