J U D G M E N T

The petitioner is the owner in possession of a property in Re.Sy.No.8/9 of Karavaram Village. He alleges that his property was subjected to aggression by the 2nd respondent panchayath on its eastern side and he made a complaint on 23.10.2001 regarding the said aggression to the District Collector, Thiruvananthapuram. As evidenced by Ext.P2, the petitioner has submitted a representation before the 1st respondent. The petitioner has come up before this Court for a direction to respondents 1 and 3 to take action on Ext.P2 representation submitted by him.

2. Heard both sides.

3. As the prayer in this writ petition is only for a direction to respondents 1 and 3 to take action on Ext.P2 representation, this Court is of the view that the writ
