JUDGMENT

The petitioner was earlier posted on light duty as evident by Exhibit P5 memorandum. This was on account of the fact that he suffered permanent disability. The petitioner asserts that the permanent disability has been assessed at 40%. The petitioner has by Exhibit P6 representation sought for continued posting on light duty.
