JUDGMENT

Being aggrieved of Ext.P1 order dated 22.07.2014 passed by the 2nd respondent, the petitioner has already moved the 1st respondent by way of Ext.P2 Revision Petition. The prayer is to cause the same to be considered and disposed of within a reasonable time.

2. Heard the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the Devaswom Board as well.

3. In view of the limited extent of relief sought for and proposed to be given, this Court does not find it necessary to deal with the merits of the case or to issue notice to respondents 3 to 7.

4. In the said circumstances, there will be a direction to the 1st respondent to consider and pass and consider Ext.P2 in accordance with law, after hearing an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and also respondents 3 to 7. This exercise shall

be done at the earliest, at any rate, within 'one month' from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.

The petitioner shall produce a copy of this judgment, along with a copy of the writ petition, before the 1st respondent, for further steps.

The writ petition is disposed of.
