J U D G M E N T

The petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayers:

- "i. Call for the records leading to Ext.P11 and set aside the same by issuing a writ of certiorari or any other appropriate writs.*
- ii. a direction to the 6th respondent that conduct an enquiry against ninth respondent in respect of the submission of Ext.P11 report.*
- iii. Declare that the fifth respondent is not eligible for the premature release from the jail by way of writ of declaration.*
- iv. Such other relief's as this Hon'ble Court deems fit to grant in the nature of this case."*

2. When the matter came up for consideration before this Court on 17.03.2015, the following interim order was passed:

"The learned counsel appearing for the 5th respondent as well as the learned Government Pleader appearing for the respondents 1 to 4 and 6 to 8 submit that WP(C) No.4995 of 2015 has become infructuous in the light of Annexure R3(a) order dated 21.02.2015 produced along with the statement filed in WP(C) No.5983 of 2015.
