J U D G M E N T

The only prayer made in the writ petition is for the issuance of a Clearance Certificate in respect of the vehicle bearing registration No. KL-9/K-7244 by keeping the permit under suspended animation and without insisting for surrender of the existing regular permit issued in respect of that vehicle to operate on the route Valiazheekkal - Thottappally.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

In the circumstances, the writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents to consider Exhibit P2 request made by the petitioner for the issuance of Clearance Certificate in respect of stage carriage bearing registration

No. KL-9/K-7244, and pass orders thereon by keeping the permit under suspended animation and without insisting for surrender of the existing regular permit. The needful in the matter shall be done within one week from the date of production of a copy of this judgment, provided all dues to the Government, including check reports, and also the Kerala Motor Transport Workers' Welfare Fund Board with respect to the vehicle are satisfied. The petitioner shall produce the current records of the vehicle sought to be substituted within a period of four months from today, failing which the same shall stand revoked.
