JUDGMENT

Being aggrieved of Ext.P1 order passed by the 1st respondent ordering restoration of the property concerned, under Section 13 of the Act 28 of 2008, the petitioner has moved the 4th respondent by way of Ext.P2 revision petition under Section 28 of the Act and the prayer is to cause the same to be considered and disposed of within a reasonable time.
