- I. To issue a writ of mandamus or any appropriate order or direction to the respondent to dispose of Ext.P3 within such period as directed by this Hon'ble Court.*
- II. Pass such other writ order or direction that this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case and to direct the respondent to pay costs to the petitioner.*

3. Considering the limited extent of relief sought for, this Court does not find it necessary to adjudicate the issue on merits.
