JUDGMENT

The petitioner challenges Exhibit P3 notice for revenue recovery. Admittedly there is a decree passed against the petitioner, which is dated 30.06.2014. The petitioner contends that she has not received a certified copy of the decree and, hence, cannot file an appeal, which she intends to do.
