JUDGMENT

The petitioner retired as Headmaster in an aided school. The petitioner submits that his pension benefits were not paid within the time. This was paid after seven months and 20 days. The petitioner also pointed out in Ext.P4 letter that he has no objection in withholding pension towards any objection for disbursing pensionary benefits. In spite of that, the petitioner submits that there was laches on the part of the officials in releasing the pension. The petitioner submits that he is entitled for interest for the belated payment. Accordingly, the petitioner has approached the Government by Ext.P6. The petitioner's only limited request made before this Court is for an early disposal of Ext.P6.

Considering the facts and circumstances, there shall be a direction to the first respondent to consider and pass appropriate orders on Ext.P6 after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within a period of four months.

The writ petition is disposed of as above.
