JUDGMENT

Shaffique, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court seeking police protection. Petitioner is the District Body Building Association. According to them, they are waiting for the National Body Building Championship. Petitioner apprehends obstruction by the 4th respondent and their men on account of certain issues relating to the said Association.

2. Learned State Attorney, on instructions, submitted that the 4th respondent is residing at Ernakulam. In their enquiry, it did not reveal that any untoward incident would happen during the championship. However, being a national championship, police force will be available in that premise to

ensure that law and order is maintained.
